Joplin Schools were long overdue to replace their nearly 100 year old middle school facilities, according to Mike Landis, school board president. The Joplin school board led the campaign and successfully passed a \$57.3 million dollar school bond issue in April of 2007 to accomplish just that. January 4, 2010 marked the ribbon cutting for the new South Middle School facility, a 140,000 square foot state of the art facility constructed by RE Smith Construction.

RE Smith Construction broke ground on South on March 27, 2008. Classes began on the 60 acre campus on January 5, 2010.

The \$18 million project represents Joplin School's continuing commitment to educational excellence. "The facility is simply awesome; we are all very pleased," said Steve Gilbreth, principal at South Middle School. Richard Nepote served as Project Manager, with Greg Keller as Project Superintendent, & Vince Brannon, Architect.

O orthopaedic Specialists of the 4 States welcomed friends, family and community leaders to tour their new offices and orthopedic medical center in a New Year's Eve celebration on Dec 31, 2009 from 4 - 8 p.m. The facility is located on West 7th Street & the Kansas State Line Road.

The \$6.7 million facility provides 52,000 square feet for regional orthopedic care that features doctors' offices, exam rooms, a complete rehabilitation gymnasium, hydrotherapy pool, a surgical center and MRI services.

Rodney Longenecker was Project Manager for the medical facility, and Tom Jones was superintendent.

The facility broke ground September, 2008. Phase I was completed by December 24th, 2009, and the doors opened for patients in the facility on January 4, 2010.
